The HIV/AIDS Bureau's Division of Community Based HIV/AIDS Programs will be holding a technical assistance webinar for funding opportunity announcement HRSA-18-052, for the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part F Dental Reimbursement Program (DRP). The purpose of this program is to improve access to oral health care services for low income, uninsured, and underserved people living with HIV (PLWH), and to train dental students, dental hygiene students, and dental residents to deliver dental care to PLWH. The DRP accomplishes this by defraying a portion of unreimbursed dental care costs for low income, uninsured, and underserved PLWH incurred by accredited dental or dental hygiene education programs recognized by the Commission on Dental Accreditation.
